# TIPS FOR YOUR NHC INTERVIEW

## MOTIVATION

Are you passionate about Public Health? Medicine? Do you have personal experience? We want to learn about what makes you excited about being an NHC member

## LEARNING

What you are hoping to learn more of this year? Is there a topic or skill you are hoping to add to your repertoire? Tell us about a time you were curious about something and took it upon yourself to look deeper into it!

## SELF STARTER

## COMMUNICATION

## SERVICE

Have you volunteered in your community? Were you part of a service organization in school? No matter how big or small, we love hearing about the ways you give back!

## TEAMWORK

We are looking to see how you've collaborated with others in the past? Group projects, team sports, clubs, solving problems with coworkers...tell us all about it!



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:



## What should I wear?

Casual attire! Of course we don't want you to show up in your pajamas or gym clothes, but a nice shirt and jeans is fine by us. If you feel like suiting up, that's great too!

## What if I have technical difficulties?

If you are having issues getting onto the meeting or finding a link let us know ASAP. If your camera or microphone isn't working, we are happy to find workarounds whether that means rescheduling or switching to a phone call.

## What happens next?

After your first interview, you will hear back in two weeks. If you are selected to move forward you will interview with Program Staff from the site you applied to. After that, you will need to interview with the specific host site.
